

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 149

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 149 (“District”) will hold a special meeting on **Thursday, May 28, 2026, at 2:15 p.m.** at the offices of The Muller Law Group, PLLC, 202 Century Square Boulevard, Sugar Land, Texas 77478, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

 - a. authorization to design construction projects and approval of contracts for design of construction projects;
 - b. approval of plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids or proposals for construction projects;
 - c. review of bids, award of contracts and authorization to execute letter financing agreement for construction of projects in the service area;
 - d. approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance of projects; and
 - e. deeds, easements, utility conveyances, and consents to encroachment.
12. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
13. Stormwater Management Program, including public comments and training.
14. City of Missouri City Matters, including:
 - a. Master Drainage Plan update;
 - b. regional wastewater treatment plant matters; and
 - c. surface water distribution.

15. Fort Bend County Matters.
16. Garbage/recycling Matters, including reviewing Residential Solid Waste Collection Contract.
17. Riverstone Homeowners Association Matters.
18. Website, social media, and communications matters.
19. Report on proposed District projects, action items, and resident inquiries.
20. Next meeting date.
21. Cybersecurity Awareness Training.
